

Mt. Wolf Borough/York County Tax Collection - Tax Year 2011

Taxes may be mailed to: Charles Stambaugh Tax Collector PO Box 357, Mt. Wolf, PA 17347-0357

Taxes may be placed in the Mt. Wolf Borough Office (345 Chestnut St.) door slot at any time of the day.

Taxes may be paid in person at the Mt. Wolf Borough Office (handicapped accessible) during these times **only**:

Receipts for tax payments, made by mail, will be issued only if a self-addressed stamped envelope accompanies the payment. A service fee of \$20.00 may be charged for returned checks and status of that bill will be considered unpaid. Payments by mail will be accepted according to postmark date. No payments can be accepted after postmark date Dec 31. Cash is acceptable in person only. No personal checks after Dec 20. For liability, I cannot collect taxes in my home.

The tax collector has nothing to do with the tax rates. You must contact the taxing authority with your concerns.

Borough (2.90 mil) and County (4.15 mil) real estate taxes are levied upon property owners of Mt. Wolf Borough based on the assessment value of their property. Real estate tax bills are no longer sent to mortgage companies by the tax collector. It is the responsibility of the property owner to make a copy, to forward it to their mortgage company and to verify correct payment. There is no spring Borough per capita tax.

Borough LST Tax of \$52 is levied upon any individual who will earn \$12,000 or more from all sources including salary, commissions or other compensation from employment in Mt. Wolf Borough during that tax year. This includes all self-employment income. Employers are responsible for collecting tax from their employees on per pay period bases and providing receipts to them.
