

Northeastern School Tax Collection For Mt. Wolf Borough Tax Year 2011-2012

Taxes may be placed in the Mt. Wolf Borough Office (345 Chestnut St.) door slot at any time of the day.

Taxes may be paid in person at the Mt. Wolf Borough Office (handicapped accessible) during these times **only**.

Receipts for tax payments, made by mail, will be issued only if a self-addressed stamped envelope accompanies the tax payment. A service fee of \$20.00 may be charged for all returned checks and that tax status will be considered unpaid. Payments by mail will be accepted according to postmark date. **No personal checks after Dec 16th**. No payments after postmark date Dec 31st. Cash is acceptable only in person. For liability reasons, I cannot see taxpayers in my home.

School per capita tax (\$5) special tax (\$5) and occupation tax (\$10) is levied upon all persons residing in Mt Wolf Borough (Northeastern School District), who are at least 18 years of age. This includes college students (unless the college student has actually transferred their residence.) The \$10 occupational tax is in addition to the Local Service Tax, which is levied by the taxing authority where the person is employed. Any person who ceases to be a resident prior to July 1 shall not be liable for these taxes for the preceding school tax year. Any person who moves into the district between January 1 and June 30 will not be liable for these taxes until after July 1.

Exonerations: Exoneration from the school occupation tax is allowed to any individual who last year received no income (not including social security). Exoneration from the per capita / special taxes are allowed to any individual (including college students) who last year (January thru December) received not more than \$5,000 from all sources of income (including social security salary).

School real estate tax must be paid by property owners in Mt Wolf Borough based on the property's assessment value. The tax collector does not send real estate tax bills to mortgage companies. It is the responsibility of the property owner. The property owner should keep the Taxpayer's Copy to verify that their mortgage company is charging them the correct amount. Gaming money is automatically deducted on the bill but is only available to those approved for Homestead or Farmstead. This form does not have to be completed each year. However, the low income PA Property/Rent Rebate PA-1000 form must be completed by July 1 of each year and this is sent to you by a rebate check. For non-installment payments return only the top bill. If using the installment plan then pay the amounts according to the dates on that installment bill. If Sept 1 is missed then installments cannot be done for that year.
